

STUDENT FEES ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Students are billed for Arthur Ashe Student Health and Wellness Center (Ashe) and Counseling & Psychological Services (CAPS) services charges, insurance copays, and coinsurance on the BruinBill, an online statement accessed by students through www.my.ucla.edu. You are responsible for monitoring your BruinBill account monthly and up to 6 months after you have left the university.

Ashe and CAPS cannot bill any insurance plans other than the UC Student Health Insurance Plan (UC SHIP). You can visit the following websites for fee information. Please note, prices are subject to change without notice. Ashe: www.studenthealth.ucla.edu/fees and CAPS: www.counseling.ucla.edu

ITEMIZED STATEMENT OF SERVICES

Your insurance carrier may require an itemized statement to file a claim with your insurance carrier for reimbursement consideration. You will find your Ashe Itemized Statement of Services once you sign in to the [Ashe Patient Portal](#). For students who cannot access the Patient Portal, you may request your itemized statement from Ashe Medical Records (www.studenthealth.ucla.edu > Contact Us > Medical Records). For CAPS itemized statements, you may contact CAPS at (310) 825-0768 or www.counseling.ucla.edu.

INCOMING STUDENT HEALTH CLEARANCE AND/OR IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Prior to the start of your academic term, students are only eligible to receive the following services: blood titers, T-Spot, and immunizations for clearance purposes. Full cost of services will be billed to your BruinBill account when services are performed prior to the official term start date (when UC SHIP coverage begins). Students not enrolled in UC SHIP will be billed the full fee even after official term date.

REGISTERED STUDENTS WITH UCSHIP

During academic terms and summer:

UC SHIP covers your Ashe/CAPS in-person office visits and telemedicine encounters (telephone/Zoom) and in-house point-of-care tests at 100%. X-rays completed at Ashe will have a copay of \$5 each. Designated preventative immunizations are also covered at 100%. You are responsible for 10% of the cost for each lab test sent out, office procedures, injections, immunizations, devices/casting, etc. In-person physical therapy and acupuncture services are subject to a \$15 copay; telephone and Zoom physical therapy encounters are covered at 100%. Pharmaceutical copays run from \$5, \$25, \$40 for a 30-day supply. Refer to the [Ashe Insurance webpage](#) for further benefit and coverage information.

REGISTERED STUDENTS WHO WAIVED UCSHIP

During academic terms:

Primary Care, ASAP Clinic, and Dietician office visits are \$12. Telemedicine services via telephone/Zoom are subject to a \$49 charge per encounter. Office visits and telemedicine encounters (telephone/Zoom) with a Specialist range from \$72-\$507. You are responsible for the full cost of office procedures, send out lab tests, devices/casting, injections, immunizations, physical therapy, acupuncture and pharmaceuticals (refer to [Ashe Fees webpage](#) for price details).

During summer period:

Students waiving SHIP in the Spring quarter are charged on a Fee for Service basis in the summer, i.e. full cost for all services including Primary Care, ASAP, Dietician office visits. The visit fee is \$75 for in-person

visits and \$49 for telemedicine (telephone/Zoom) encounters. All other charges are billed at full cost as during the academic year described above. For CAPS fees, refer to [CAPS website](#) for fee schedule.

BRUINCARE

During academic terms:

You have unlimited access at no charge for in-person and telephone/Zoom encounters for Primary Care, ASAP Clinic, and Dietician visits as well as for female pap smear and in-house point-of-care lab tests. X-rays are \$5 per series. In-person Specialist visits are \$40. All other services will be billed at full cost. Bruincare coverage does not extend to the summer and ends with last official day of the academic quarter.

FEE FOR SERVICE

Students not registered for the current term and have access to the Ashe during the grace period will have an account type of Fee-For-Service. Full cost for all services provided in Ashe and CAPS will be billed to your BruinBill account.

FEES PENDING

When the current term fees have been charged but have not been paid in full students will have an account type of Fees Pending. You will be responsible for full cost of all services if term fees are not paid in full within 30 days from term start date. When fees are paid in full, Ashe/CAPS charges will be adjusted accordingly. Applicable charges will be billed to your BruinBill account (based on category above).

WITHDRAWAL FROM THE CURRENT TERM

If you withdrew from the current term and waived UCSHIP, you will be billed full cost of services based on the university effective date of withdrawal.
